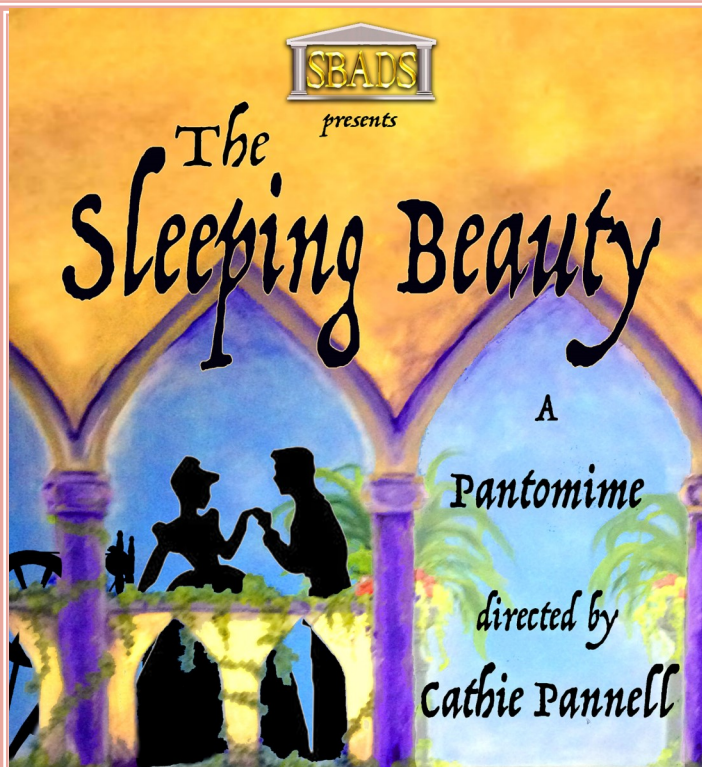
### SOCIAL EVENTS

**Advance Sale of Tickets**

Advance Sale of tickets to members will be on Sunday January 8th at 5.30 in the Committee Room at the Village Hall, payment by cash or cheque. Owing to the expected high interest in Pantomime tickets and the Saturday matinee in particular and a desire to ensure we can offer the general public ticket some choices for that performance, we have decided to reserve 4 rows out of the 12 - 52 tickets - for public sales, leaving up to 8 rows - 104 tickets - for members. Of course, in the event that member demand for the Matinee performance exceeds 104, members can purchase additional tickets once the other rows go on general sale the following day.
